CSA Historical Edition Rifle

Features

Each CSA Historical Edition Rifle is available on the American-made Henry Golden Boy (H004). Each rifle features detailed engraving on both sides of the American walnut forearm, with the name and establishment date of your county on the right side and your state name and nickname on the left side. The right side of the American walnut buttstock is engraved with an intricate, original piece of artwork that captures the unique history of your county, while the left side is reserved for custom personalization. Finally, both sides of the receiver are engraved with an elaborate scroll and banner pattern. Each rifle is individually numbered on the left side of the receiver, for example an edition of 1000 rifles would be no. 0001, no.0002 and so on up to no. 1000.

Personalization

Personalizations are engraved on the left side of the stock. They can be up to 3 lines and 30-35 characters long. To personalize the gun there is an additional cost of \$35. Here are examples of the personalization templates.



Production Time

Finding A Dealer

By law we are required to ship the gun to a licensed dealer. It is the customer's responsibility to find a dealer they would like to use and to have the dealer fax us his FFL (Federal Firearms License). The dealer will run a background check and will most likely charge a small fee of around \$30. This price varies depending on the state and region. Please fax the FFL to 970-692-5324.
